## **Program Description**

Lafayette Parish Correctional Industries (LAPCORR) is a jail industry program where inmates work in a factory-like setting while incarcerated. The environment fosters productive inmate activity which often reduces idleness that leads to disciplinary problems. Due to the scarcity of these types of jobs while incarcerated, the program encourages continued good behavior so that the individual remains qualified for the position.

Successful re-integration into the community is a priority of the industry and inmates are trained in quality, safety, productivity and good work ethics. Performance evaluations are administered by staff of the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office on inmates working at LAPCORR thereby teaching them how to work and deal with real world employment issues.

LAPCORR Industries manufactures and sells quality can liners for trash and garbage use to any government or non-profit agency in the state of Louisiana.
