



# LAFAYETTE PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE REENTRY PROGRAM

### Program Eligibility considerations:

1. **No open local or state charges**
2. **Time calculated by the Department of Corrections**
3. **Participate in Reentry assessments**
4. **No Department of Corrections write-ups**
5. **Residing in the Lafayette area upon release**

**(Some charges may exclude outside programming)**

The Reentry Program includes intervention strategies that will help deter the recidivism of offenders. The approach will help offenders in acquiring services needed to become law-abiding, productive citizens within their community. While participating in the program, offenders reside at the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office Work Release facility. Upon completion of the Reentry program, you may be transferred to Work Release status if approved through the Department of Corrections.

### Program includes, but is not limited to:

- Mental health services
- Drug and alcohol treatment
- Employment Training
- Family reunification
- Moral Reconciliation Therapy
- Literacy and GED prep
- Computer Aided Instruction
- KeyTrain, ACT Preparation, Computer Skills
- Financial planning
- Life skills (DOC's 100 hour Pre-Release curriculum)
- Transitional Services
- ID's , Housing, Clothing, Medical, Employment
- Technical School & College application assistance
- Narcotics Anonymous
- Financial aid Information

- Custodial Management Training
- Anger Management
- Thinking for a Change
- Journaling (Dealing with Grief)
- Relapse Prevention
- Courage to Change
- Relationships in Life
